Question 3: Assessment	25	23–25: Thorough evaluation of assessment strategies, including discussion of validity and reliability	20–22: Thorough evaluation of assessment strategies, including discussion of validity and reliability, but minor gaps in discussion of validity and/or reliability	18–19: Basic evaluation with limited discussion of validity/reliability	0–17: Minimal evaluation with no or incorrect discussion of validity/reliability

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Question 4: Proposed Revisions	25	23–25: 2–4 major changes thoughtfully justified; clearly improve student learning, motivation, and/or assessment.	20–22: 2–4 changes with reasonable justification ; some minor gaps in connection to theories.	18–19: Only 1 change with limited justification ; connections to theories are weak .	0–17: Few or no changes, or changes not justified; weak or missing theory connections.
